

Life Cycle of a Plant

- 1. A seed falls on the ground.
- 2. The seed germinates that means it starts to grow.
- 3. The seed grows roots and a stem. It is called a seedling. A seedling is a baby plant.
- 4. The roots grow into the ground. The stem grows up to the sky.
- 5. The seedling grows two leaves.
- 6. The seedling grows taller and taller.
- 7. The seedling is not a baby anymore. It is a plant.
- 8. The plant grows flowers.
- 9. The flowers make new seeds.
- 10. The seeds fall on the ground and it starts again at step one!
